# **Casting and Auditions**

General note: If you are involved in the ADC theatre you can expect the same procedures and expectations.

#### **For Actors**

Taking part in a film:

- •Auditions will normally be advertised on Camdram (normally under CUFA but do check normal advertisements too), Facebook, or on CUFA's weekly newsletter.
- •Let audition holders know if you are unable to make the audition
- Make sure you have a CUFA membership.
- •Speak out about anything which makes you uncomfortable, has not been prior agreed, or if you have any concerns. Contact lfj23@cam.ac.uk if you have any questions/welfare concerns that you cannot/do not want to raise with production (although they should be your first point of contact, unless of course you are in an unsafe situation).

### Additional welfare advice

- •You do not have to do anything you are not comfortable with, regardless of whether you once agreed to it.
- •You are entitled to regular breaks during shooting hours
- Every member of the team including actors and production are equally important- there should be no hierarchy.

## **Fair Casting**

CUFA believes in fair and responsible casting.

This means you must:

- •Advertise and hold open auditions (your friends may audition but you must keep an unbiased opinion and allow everyone a chance to show their talents).
- Prioritise Cambridge students.
- •Acknowledge any triggers/content warnings when advertising auditions
- •Let both successful and unsuccessful applicants know the outcome of their audition (as quickly as possible).
- •Always consider diversity when casting a film/project.
- •Contact lfj23@cam.ac.uk if you have any questions/welfare concerns.

- •Advertise on Camdram (it is advised to affiliate CUFA with your advertisement, but it is also possible to do without).
- Facebook is another great advertisement tool, specifically in the 'Cambridge Theatre' Facebook group.
